# Winter Light Parade 2021 Rules and Regulations

Please initial each rule that you have read them and understand it

\_\_\_ After line up you will be given a number. Please make sure that number is displayed on the passenger side window of your vehicle. If that isn't possible, please just do the best you can somewhere on that side toward the front of your float so the judges will see it.

\_\_\_ We ask floats to start lining up @ 5pm . We ask that everyone is lined up by 5:30 . You can come before and prepare your float in the parking lot behind Edward where the Pick Me Up is located. You just pull up right behind the floats already in line. Sponsors will be placed in front of the parade.

\_\_\_ We ask the floats to be festive and strongly suggest a minimum of 1500 light. The more lights the better! Please deck out your float as much as you can.

\_\_\_ All vehicles must also be decorated. For non-float entries, each car/motorcycle/bicycle/individual/animal in the group must be decorated and have some form of lighting. No exceptions!

\_\_\_ For safety reasons, every float entry must have a minimum of 2 spotters (one for each side of your float). This is for safety reasons and they will need to make sure that people stay away from your float. It's strongly encouraged for those spotters to also be decorated with lights, but not required. We'd rather have spotters without lights but with something reflective on rather than no spotters at all.

\_\_\_ To keep children from running into the road, candies, novelties, toys, advertising material, and etc. **MAY NOT BE THROWN** directly from any parade float but from the sidewalk area only. Accompanying walking spotters may distribute (not throw) items along the sides of the parade route. This rule will be strictly enforced.

\_\_\_ During the parade, each entry should maintain a safe distance of about 30-40 feet between them and the unit in front of them. Please keep up with the unit in front of you to avoid gaps!

\_\_\_ **No Santa Claus of any kind may be used in any entry. There will be just one Santa Claus at the end of the parade. Santa hats are acceptable.**

\_\_\_ All animals in the parade must always be under control. Horse riders are strongly encouraged to wear helmets. Every animal group is required to have a clean-up crew. Units without a clean-up crew will not be allowed to participate.

\_\_\_ Parade entries must be appropriate for all ages, values, and sensibilities, and may not include language, attire, and/or behavior that is profane, sexual, violent, or discriminatory and must be consistent with the holiday or winter theme.

\_\_\_ Headlights must be turned off during the parade while in the parade to showcase the holiday floats.

\_\_\_ All vehicles need to be in good running order and able to idle for long periods of time without overheating or stalling. They all need to have a full tank of gas and proof of insurance.

## Rules and Regulations Page 2

\_\_\_All floats must have a 5lb fire extinguisher. If this is an issue, please contact us.

\_\_\_Due to power lines your float can not be taller than 13 ft

\_\_\_All generators must be tied down and for safety reasons we were asked that they are not 100% full. The parade route is not big. So just fill it up for what you will need.

\_\_\_Use only non-combustible or flame-retardant decorations

\_\_\_All city and state law and ordinance must be followed. The Winter Light Parade has the right to add rules as they see fit.

\_\_\_ Please follow map routes and instructions. Do not turn off midway into the park . Please follow straight through. If you would like to go to the park and enjoy the festivities that follow. Please make sure you find a safe place away from traffic to park your float.

Please read this carefully before signing. In consideration of permission from the Winter Parade to participate in the Winter parade, and intending to be legally bound, I affirm that I have read and understand the attached rules and regulations, and I agree to comply with them always. I acknowledge that my participation in the parade carries risks, some of which are unknown, and with that knowledge I do assume all such risks. I agree that I am solely responsible for all injuries or damage that I cause or incur. On behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and personal representatives, I hereby forever indemnify, release and forever hold the Winter Parade harmless from any and all real or possible losses, claims, actions, judgments for damages, expenses, harm or injury to myself or other persons, and/or to property incurred in relation to my participation in the Parade not attributable to the tortious conduct of parade, regardless of the manner by which such claim may be brought.
